Description:	<p>A biconvex, cast lead spindle whorl with moulded pseudo-letters on one side, and a wavy line between pellets on the other.</p> <p>The dating of lead spindle whorls is problematic, as similar examples have been found in contexts that span the period from Roman to late medieval times. The consensus is that most of them date to the later medieval period.</p>
